



To most football fans, the Ohio State/ Alabama showdown was a national semifinal playoff game wrapped inside the traditional Sugar Bowl from the New Orleans Superdome.


For Mike, a Crestline native, and some 3,000 young men across the country, the game had a distinct Team Focus flavor.

Even though Mike lives in Crimson Tide country, he rooted for both teams during the Sugar Bowl game. He's developed strong ties with Ohio State Coach Urban Meyer and Alabama Coach Nick Saban through their charitable efforts.

Heading into the Sugar Bowl, they not only owned six national championships between them, but they've raised funds approaching \$1 million from their appearances at Team Focus functions.

The Meyer-Gottfried connection goes back to Meyer's high school playing career at Ashtabula St. John. Meyer often pokes fun at himself by noting that Gottfried was the only major college coach to send him a recruiting letter. Gottfried was coaching at Cincinnati.

"I'm impartial because I know what all these (coaches) go through. I've been there, done that," said Gottfried, who turned around programs at Cincinnati, Kansas and Pittsburgh as a head coach. "I expected it to be a good game. Both teams have been great and both teams have great stories at quarterback."



There's no denying the huge emotional investment Mike had in the Sugar Bowl. He watched the game from home with fellow Crestline native Rocky Alt (the Ohio Team Focus Chapter Director), along with some Team Focus members from Alabama, Ohio, Texas and Michigan.

"(Coach Meyer and Coach Saban) are true winners and I knew they were headed toward playing each other," Gottfried said. "And they're going to be going at each other for a long time because they're able to recruit."

"It's two of the best jobs in the country, with two of the best facilities in the country, two of the best locations in the country for recruiting, and they have two of the best coaches."

January 12, 2015 Ohio State Beat Oregon 42-20 to Win the College Football Playoff National Championship Presented by AT&T.

ARLINGTON, Texas -- Ohio State was done when Braxton Miller got hurt in August. Ohio State was done when it lost at home to Virginia Tech in September. Ohio State was done when J.T. Barrett got hurt in November. A funny thing happened: Every time the Buckeyes looked done, they kept getting better. And in the new era of college football, that was enough to earn a chance to win a championship.

"This will go down as one of the great stories in college football history," Coach Urban Meyer said.










Talking Points with Pastor Rey Dempsey





Here are a couple basic rules for you to remember around your house and when you are a guest.


Always clean up the sink and shower after you use the bathroom by checking to see if you have left toothpaste in the sink or hair in the drain and always hang up your towel.

Nine years ago, single mother Julie Heaton saw a segment on the evening news about young men without fathers taking part in a year-round mentoring program in Mobile. She leaned in, watching as the fresh-faced teens learned the proper way to put on a neck tie. Heaton quickly jotted down a phone number included in the story. She called the Team Focus offices the next day.

Her son, Jakob Bush, ten at the time, was desperately in need of a father figure in his life. His father left when he was 3. Julie and Jakob have been a part of the Team Focus family for nearly a decade now.

Through Christian values and leadership training, Team Focus members build long-term relationships with young men who lack a strong or present father figure. The year-round community-centered program focuses on positive influences and role models — including high-profile, nationally-recognized

collegiate and professional athletes and coaches - for these young men through individual mentoring, tutoring, monthly social activities, leadership camps and scholarship opportunities.

"The need is great," said Mike Gottfried, about why Team Focus has continued to grow for the past 14 years. "The need is greater as time goes on."

Jakob Bush, now a 19 year old college freshman at Faulkner University in Montgomery, said members of Team Focus stepped in when his grades dropped as a high school freshman. They helped him get a scholarship to attend a private high school his mother would have never been able to afford on her own. Later, Mike and Joe Gottfried took Jakob and other young men to visit college campuses across Alabama and beyond, eventually helping him find a way to attend a Christian college. Jakob has

a scholarship to play baseball at Faulkner University, something he credits to Team Focus.

Julie Heaton says she is grateful to be part of the Team Focus family. "They were there on the bench with me at practices," she said. "They were there when I called. They would sit and talk to Jakob about respect. We quickly found out you don't do anything by yourself. You do it together."


